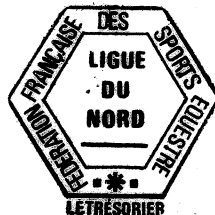

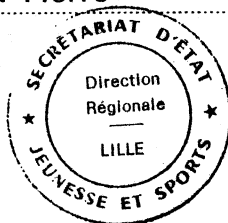


Dear Mr. Stilwell:
